



KIAORA WELCOME TO HELENA BAY LODGE



Nestled in a sheltered bay along the north-east coast of New Zealand, this property features five kilometres of pristine coastline, four private beaches and many intimate coves. National Geographic Traveller Magazine ranked this location second-equal in The World's Top-Rated Islands, Coastlines and Beaches.

Helena Bay Lodge prides itself on providing an exclusive, private experience at one of the most unique lodges in New Zealand.

OUR STORY

The Helena Bay Lodge insignia is based on the ruru, New Zealand's only remaining native owl. A bird of the bush and the night, the ruru – also known as the 'morepork' in reference to it's 'more–pork' call – is an important species to the Māori culture, holding deep spiritual and cultural meaning. With the scientific name of Niox novaeseelandiae. this shy bird has many titles in Māori, including ruru, koukou and peho.

The call of the morepork is iconic in New Zealand, with their haunting 'more-pork' cry being heard in our native forests from dusk through to dawn. It's also possible to hear their repetitive 'cree' sound — a cry which Māori legend holds as a forewarning of bad news. The morepork lives in abundance on the Helena Bay Estate, where you will hear them calling to each other throughout the night.



HISTORY

Helena Bay is a very special place.

Known to the local Māori as Mimiha – meaning 'small black fish' – this region has a long history of both Māori and European habitation, with numerous archaeological sites remaining in the area. The coastline boasts many prominent and very visible pā sites (former Māori fortifications).

There are several pā sites on the Helena Bay Lodge estate grounds. An archaeological estimate has suggested that perhaps up to 250 people may have called this land their home. With direct access to the ocean providing an abundant food source and the terrain affording excellent defence, this is not surprising. There also remains clear evidence of cultivation on the property with kumara (native sweet potato) pits and terraces remaining today.

The Helena Bay name came from the first European woman settler, Mrs Helena Hutchinson. She and her husband Charles started the first store in this bay. Mrs Hutchinson was a kind woman who worked with local Māori, teaching and nursing. Out of deep respect the locals renamed the bay after her.

During the Lodge construction, two kō (Māori digging instruments) were unearthed and sent to the National Museum for preservation.

What lifts Helena Bay beyond your average slice of 'unspoilt' coastline is the stunning view across the bay to the protected coastal reserve of Mimiwhangata.

GYMNASIUM



WALKS ON THE PROPERTY

We have many beautiful walking trails on the property. They are signposted for your convenience. They showcase the beautiful fauna and flora that New Zealand has to offer, the flora is particularly unique in New Zealand as it has evolved in isolation for millions of years.

In the summer months the coastline of the property blazes red with glorious pohutukawa – also known as the 'New Zealand Christmas tree'. Our walking trails will take you through peaceful native bush where you will see varied plant and animal life, including the silver fern or 'ponga' which is New Zealand's national symbol.

BIRD LIFE

We have many unique and beautiful birds that wander and nest on our 800 acres. In every room you have a set of binoculars to view all the beautiful birds from your balcony or go safari-style in one of our Polaris 4WD rangers and head out bird watching for an afternoon. You might see brown teal duck, paradise ducks, pukeko, heron, fantail, kingfisher, tui, weka, hawks and many more. Listen closely at night time and you will hear ruru, New Zealand's native owl. MOUNTAIN BIKES - ELECTRIC & MANUAL

Our trails aren't just for walking, we also have mountain bikes and top of the range electric bikes for you to use. From beginner to advanced, we have tracks for every level; a great way to cover a lot of ground in a short space of time.

Additional maps are available to show the extended local area and communities, should you wish to venture further afield off the property. Speak to a member of staff who can recommend a local cycling route depending on how far you would like to go.



TENNIS COURT

Our tennis court is open to guests all year around and is floodlit for those who wish to play in the evening. If you don't have a partner to practice your backhand with we have a tennis ball machine which simulates playing, along with other various training modes to try. Alternatively, the AstroTurf can be arranged for football, volleyball or badminton. Simply call reception in advance to arrange.

GLOW-WORMS

New Zealand Glow-worms (Arachnocampa luminosa) can be found in caves or in forest settings, often on damp overhanging stream banks. Their light is made from a biochemical reaction called bioluminescence and they are able to turn it off when there is too much light, for example sunlight.

Sudden loud noises often make them glow brighter. They can be found at Helena Bay Lodge on the creek down our driveway, why not see these fascinating and magical creatures in their natural habitat?

Use of the mountain bikes, tennis court and tour of the glow-worms are complimentary for guests.



CLAYBIRD SHOOTING





Aim, fire and experience the thrill of claybird shooting at our shooting range.

Hidden amidst Helena Bay's 800 acres, this picturesque, unspoiled location is the perfect spot to fire away for an unforgettable experience.

Whether you are a beginner, intermediate or advanced shooter, we have four automatic traps set at different levels, angles and speeds to suit any ability. We have both 12 gauge and 20 gauge over-and-under 'Miroku' shotguns to match your skill level. Crafted with precision, Miroku shotguns are the perfect example of what a sporting gun should be.

Ammunition is included and you have a licensed guide present during your session to give you tips on becoming a sharp shooter.

FISHING

Keen on fishing but don't want to venture out too far? Then why not enjoy an afternoon by the water on our very own pontoon. We have an extensive range of top quality fishing equipment and can put down burley to attract plenty of fish.

Cast out into the reef waters of Helena Bay where you can find an abundance and vast variety of fish. Snapper is one of New Zealand's highly prized eating fish and is often caught off our jetty or surrounding rocks. Bring back any 'keepers' and our Head Chef will prepare and cook it for you - it doesn't get much fresher than that!

Please be aware that New Zealand has strict marine conservation laws, including size and quantity of catch. We will provide you with all necessary measuring equipment and will advise you of your catch limit for each species.

KAYAKING

We have a beautiful and fascinating natural coastline waiting for you to explore. We have top of the range Barracuda Kayaks for you to try, including fishing kayaks and our incredibly light weight sea kayaks. Not only is it a great way to explore our property from the water it is also a great way to improve your fitness and strength.

STAND UP PADDLEBOARDING & SNORKELING

With a range of wetsuits, fins and snorkel gear why not set off on an adventure and discover the local shorelines nearby? RURU



Designed from the keel up with safety and comfort in mind, it comes fully equipped with two bathrooms and a hot freshwater shower. Spacious indoor and outdoor areas ensure that no matter the weather, enjoyment, comfort and shelter from the elements are available. The cabin is also fully air-conditioned for summer.

Ruru is the perfect vessel for fishing the local waters, and we have all the equipment required, no matter which type of fishing you enjoy.

For those wishing to explore the nearby coastline, Bay of Islands and Poor Knights Islands our friendly crew can take care of up to twelve guests at a time. We also have stand up paddleboards, kayaks and snorkeling gear onboard, along with wet weather jackets if required.

Several trip options are available, including full and half-day charters. All our trips can be customised to ensure everyone makes the most of their time on-board.




